| <u>CHECK IN TO SEE IF YOUR CHILD CAN STILL FLUENTLY ADD AND SUBTRACT TO 10.</u> (PRACTICE WITH FLASH CARDS!) | Write about a vacation/trip that you took with your family. Then add an illustration! | Empty some of the coin-collecting jar at home. Sort them out and tell someone what each coin is worth! |
